Our guide to help you prepare for arranging a Funeral

In order to ensure that the day of the Funeral runs as smoothly as possible it is necessary for us to ask you quite a few questions. These relate to every area of the Funeral and help us to arrange for exactly what you want. Below is a list of questions that we would need answered to complete the arrangements. (Some questions may be specific to burial or cremation)

What days and times would be most suitable to the family?

Are there any times or days you wish us to avoid?

Do you have anyone travelling any distance to the funeral?

What address would you like us to pick you up from?

Where would you like us to take you back to?

Do you require us to arrange catering for you?

How many limousines, if any, might you require?

Would you like us to place any newspaper notices for you?

If so, which newspapers?

Have you thought about the content of the notices?

If it is going to be a cremation, which crematorium would
you like to use?

If it is going to be a burial, which cemetery will we be

going to?

Is there an existing grave, or will it need to be a new grave?
Would you like a Church service to take place prior to the
burial or cremation?

If so, which Church do you wish to use?

Do you know what you would like to have happen with
the ashes after a cremation?

If the person is wearing jewellery, are we to leave it with
them, or return it to you?

Would you require a printed order of service, or attendance
cards?

Is there any special CD music you would like to have
played?

This is not an exhaustive list, but hopefully will prepare you for some of the things we will need to discuss. If you have any wishes that may seem more unusual please discuss these with us at the earliest opportunity as they can take a day or two longer to arrange.
